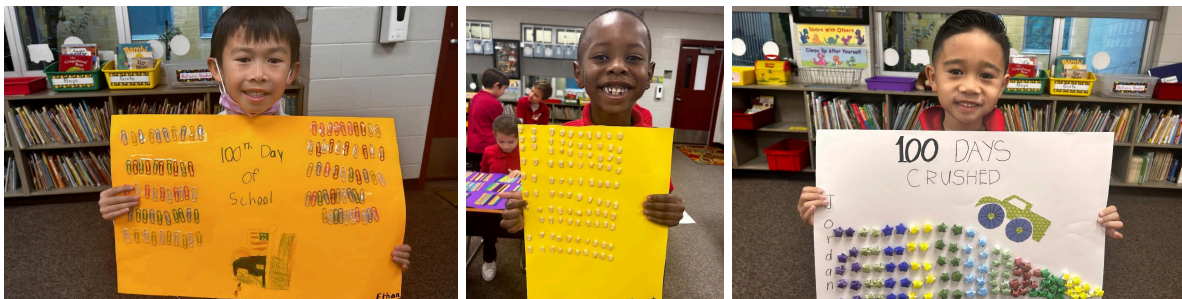


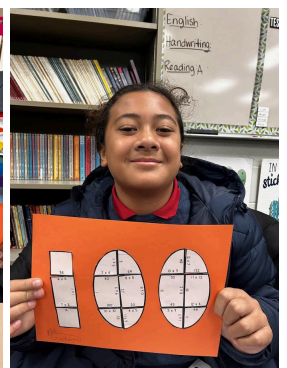
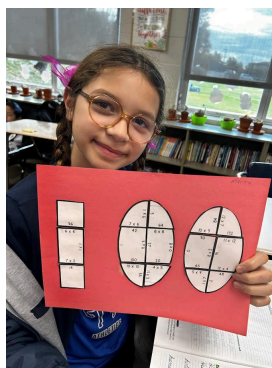
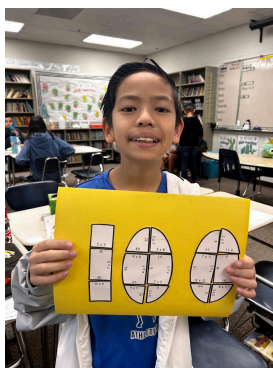
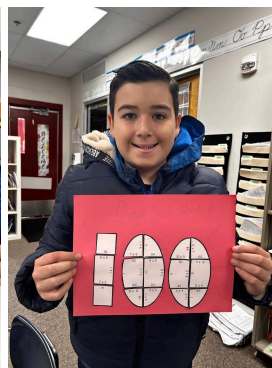
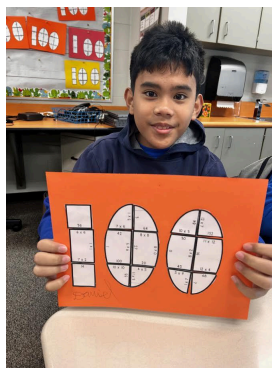
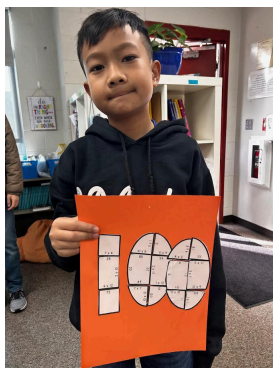
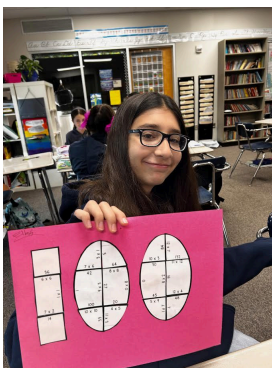
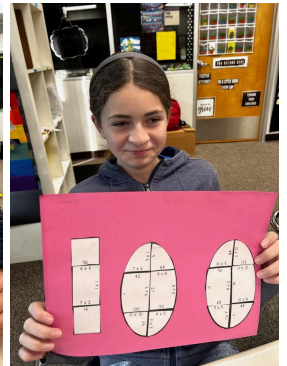
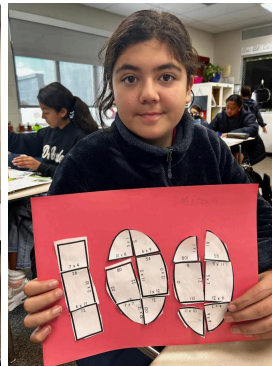
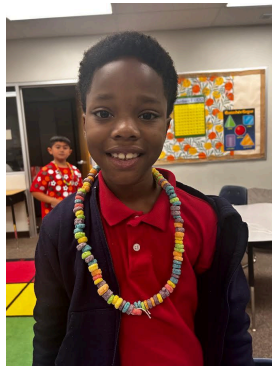
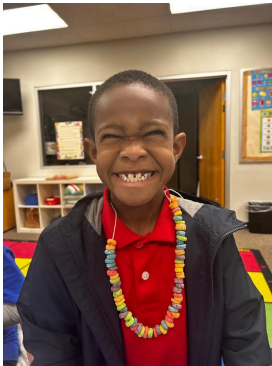
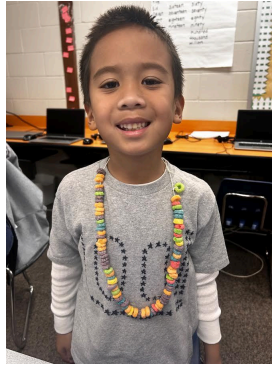
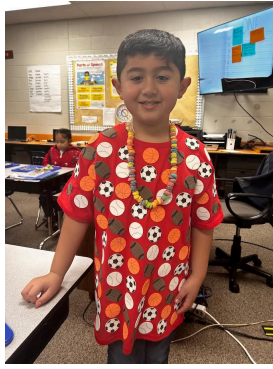


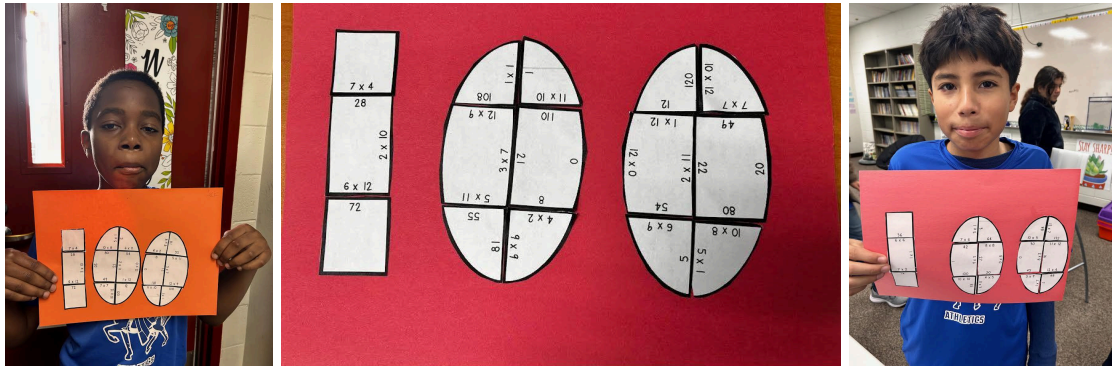
Elementary Activities

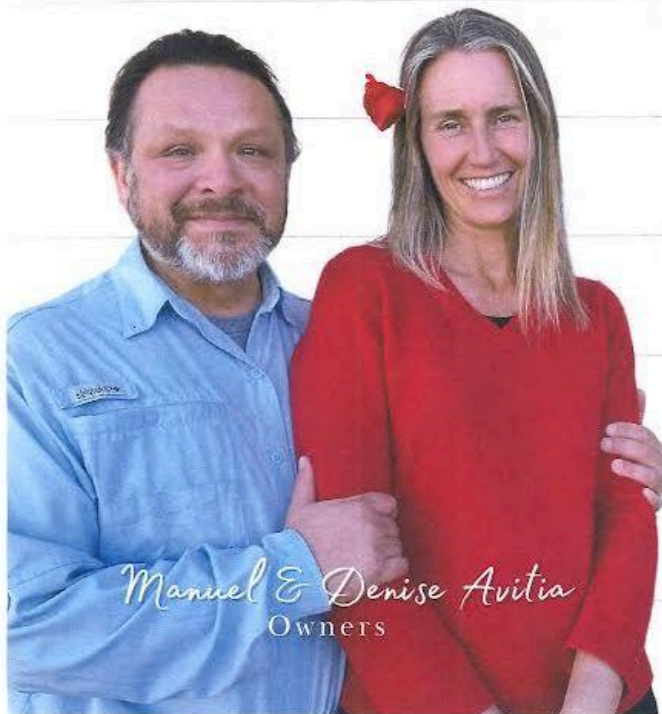
